Summer fun in the sun

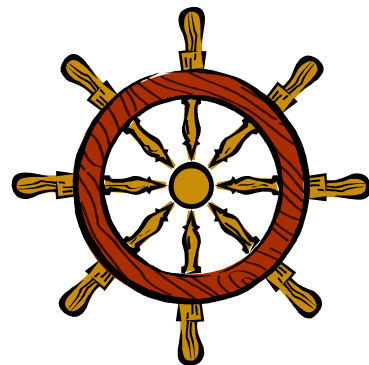

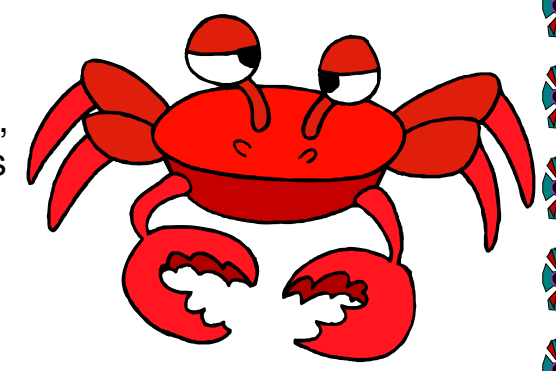


Rocky Shore Visit
