CURRICULUM DELIVERY POLICY

RATIONALE

To ensure that our students receive high quality teaching and learning within a supportive Catholic environment.

GUIDELINES

1. The school will teach the National Curriculum as required by the Ministry of Education and the Religious Education Programme, as required by the Catholic Bishops of New Zealand.
2. Our Curriculum Delivery Plan and Curriculum Statements will be used to guide the delivery and assessment of the Curriculum in each subject area.
3. A budget for the provision of resources will be developed for each Curriculum area every year.
4. Staff development will be based on the Curriculum focus of the school and the needs of staff identified in the Performance Appraisal Process.
5. The school will continue to create opportunities to inform parents about the Curriculum. This will include Student-led Conferences, Newsletters, Curriculum evenings and the distribution of relevant publications.
6. Student achievement, progress and the effectiveness of the teaching and learning programmes, will be monitored through a cycle of self review resulting in regular reports to the BOT on student achievement, curriculum delivery and other strategic goals.
